Safeguarding Sunday is also intended to draw awareness to our need to be vigilant and to have the courage to speak up and be proactive where we become aware of the maltreatment of others. On the positive side, this is also a time where we celebrate where Safeguarding is done well with examples of people dealing with each other in a manner that all may feel safe and welcome in our churches and communities.

You will probably be relieved to know that I am now not going to give yet another opinion of the events which have dominated news regarding the Church of England this week. Everyone has an opinion and I'm sure we have all heard more than enough of other people's opinions.

With this and other events in the news in past weeks and months; some may throw up their hands and think the world has gone mad. What Jesus does guarantee is that God is with us on our journey through life guiding and loving us. As we approach the feast of Christ the King, let us pray that God's Kingdom come on earth as it is in heaven asking for the grace to play our part in this.
